

# Free Boxing Day heritage buses from Workington Monday 26 December 2016



35 to Cockermouth & Slatefell  
60 to Silloth & Skinburness

This is our main public running day of the year. Christmas falls over a weekend this year, so our volunteers will be driving on **Monday 26<sup>th</sup> December**.

Last year, for the first time on a Boxing Day, Stagecoach ran an enhanced Sunday service, meaning that we had to revise our plans at short notice. They will run a similar service again this Boxing Day.

This year we plan to repeat our 2 hourly service 35 using our *Osprey* minibus from Workington to Broughton, Cockermouth and Slatefell.

New this year is a 2 hourly service from Workington via Maryport to Allonby, Silloth and Skinburness.

Route: Workington bus station, Oxford Street, Railway Station, Tesco, Northside roundabout, Asda, main A596 road through Siddick, Flimby, Grasslot, Maryport, then B5300 through Allonby, Mawbray, Beckfoot, Blitterlees, Silloth Eden Street, Criffel St, Skinburness Road to Dick Trod Lane.
